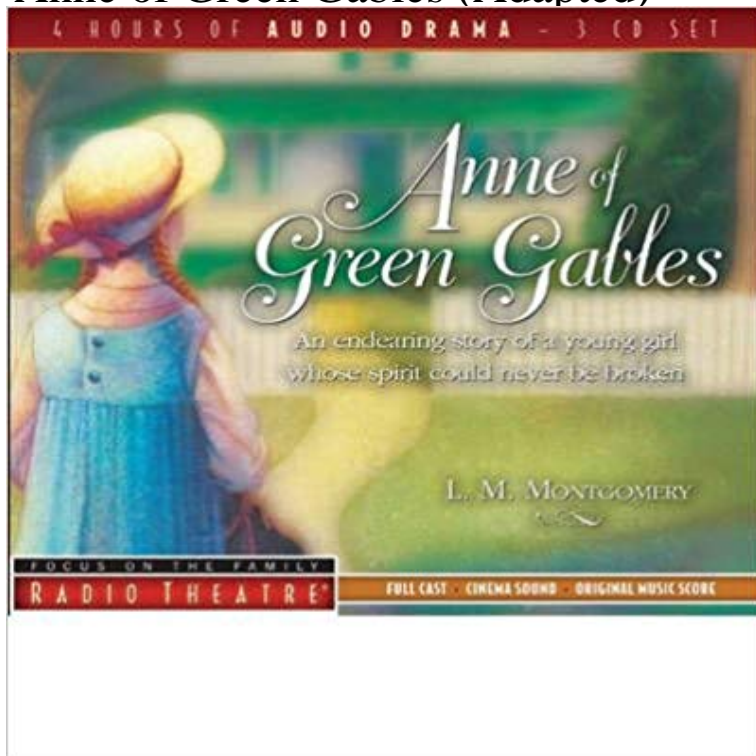


## Anne of Green Gables (Adapted)
