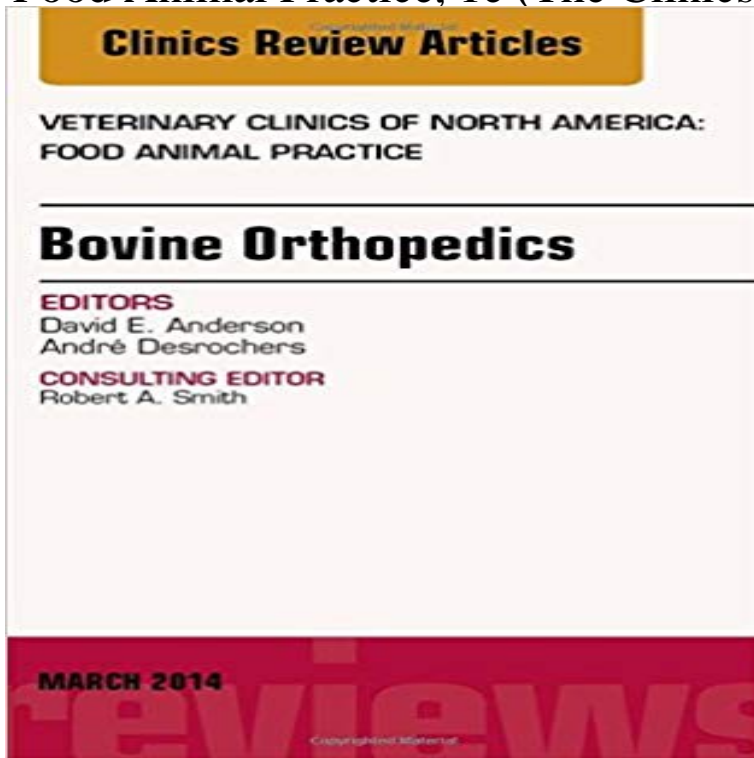


Bovine Orthopedics, An Issue of Veterinary Clinics of North America: Food Animal Practice, 1e (The Clinics: Veterinary Medicine)
