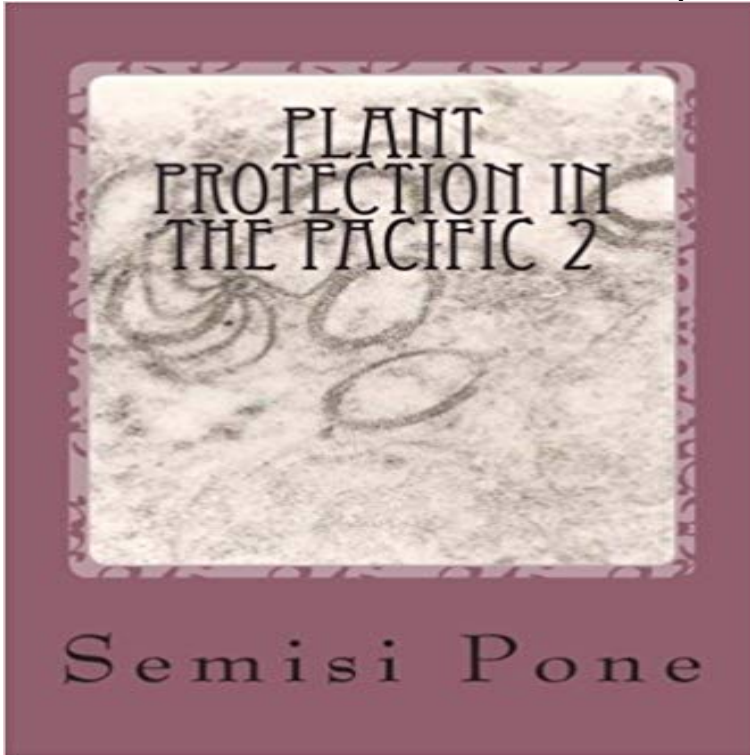


## Plant Protection in the Pacific 2: Epidemiology studies... (Volume 2)
