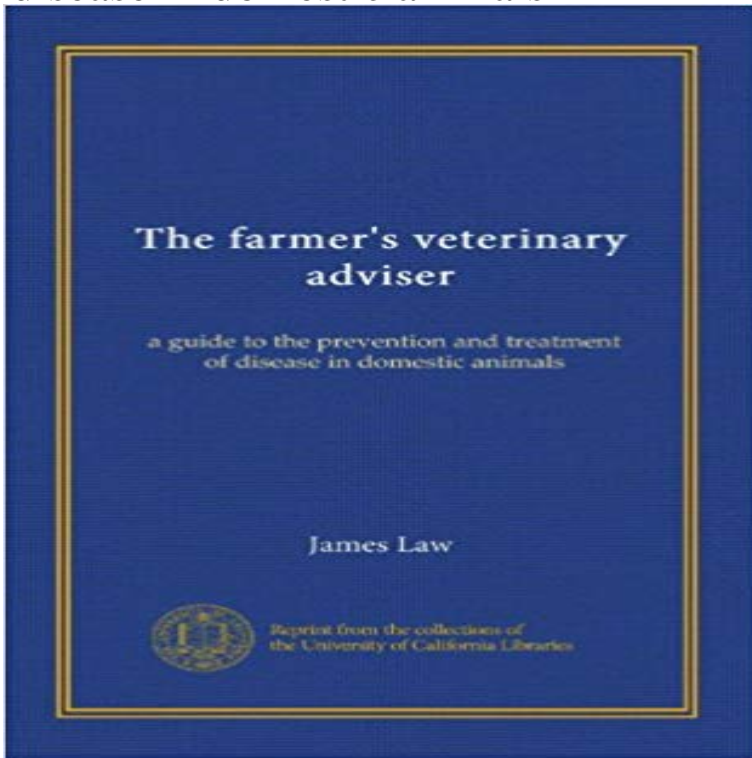


# The farmer's veterinary adviser: a guide to the prevention and treatment of disease in domestic animals
