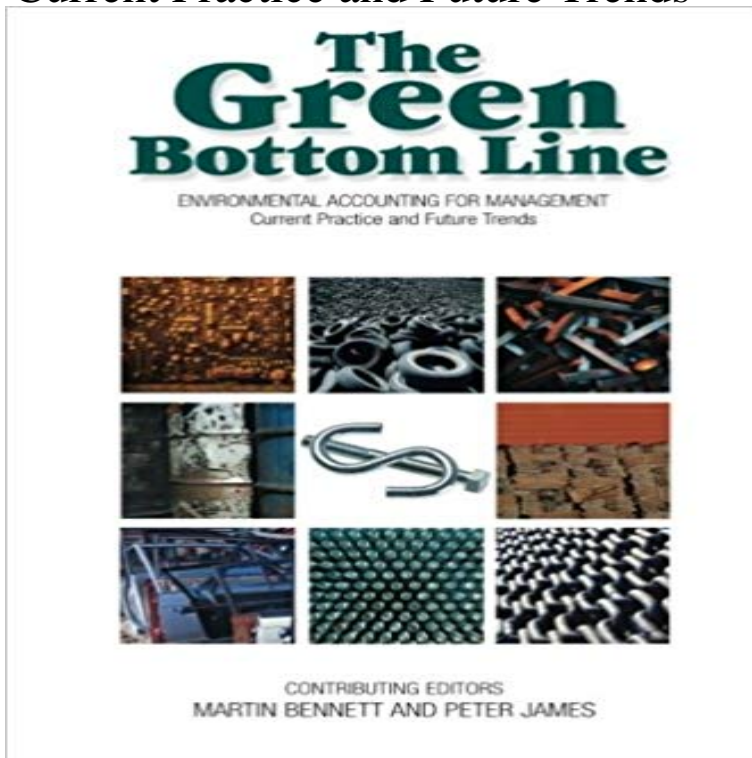


The Green Bottom Line: Environmental Accounting for Management: Current Practice and Future Trends
