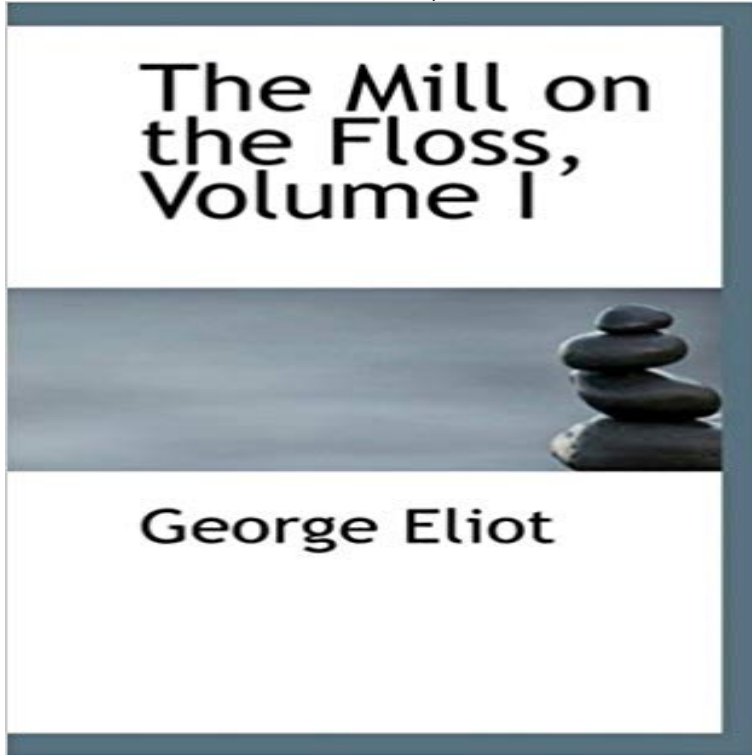


# The Mill on the Floss, Volume I
